

British Values Statement



At [Noddy's Nursery School](#) we recognise the multi-cultural, multi-faith nature of the United Kingdom and understand the crucial role our nursery plays in promoting these values.

We encourage admissions from all those entitled to education under British Law regardless of faith, ethnicity, gender and sexuality, political or financial status. We are a nursery for all.

This statement outlines the key British Values we actively promote.

Democracy: Making decisions together

- We use circle time to make decisions together
- We encourage sharing and turn taking
- We encourage children to talk about their feelings e.g. When they do or do not need help
- We encourage children to value each-others views and values by listening to each other
- We encourage children to volunteer to be a helper of the day, line leader or door holder
- We encourage children to choose their own activities or resources through child led play and learning



Mutual Respect and Tolerance: Treat others as you want to be treated

- We promote an attitude of equality and fairness
- We challenge perceptions
- We promote diversity through resources and activities
- We respect and celebrate multi-cultural and multi-faith events
- We support and participate in charitable events
- We welcome the local community through spontaneous outings and nursery visits
- We enjoyed a varied lunch menu; making changes to individual needs and cultural events
- Good manners are always promoted
- We listen to and respect others opinions and values

Individual Liberty: Freedom for All

- We help the children take ownership of their behaviour; knowing it affects their right and the rights of others.
- We encourage the children to make their own choices
- We encourage the children to express their likes and dislikes
- We allow the children to choose where and what they play with
- We plan for children's individual learning to support and encourage development
- We provide opportunities for the children to take risks on an obstacle course developing their confidence



Rule of Law: Understanding Rules

- We act as positive role models for children to model positive behaviour
- We follow our nursery's Behaviour Management Policy
- We encourage parents to support us with managing the children's behaviour
- We collaborate with the children to create 'Golden Rules'
- We set boundaries so children can learn to distinguish right from wrong
- We help children understand their own and others' behaviour and its consequences
